DAY 1 Cagliari

Welcome to Cagliari, Sardinia's capital. Cagliari, located on the Bay of Angels, is an ancient, fortified city that has seen the rule of civilisations for over 5000 years. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy an evening at leisure.

STAY 3 NIGHTS: Hotel Villa Fanny 4-star or similar

DAY 2 Cagliari (B)

Enjoy a half day morning walking tour of the historic medieval Castello with its ancient fortifications, 14th century towers and town hall. Visit Piazza Palazzo, The Cathedral of Santa Maria, The Bastion of St Remy, Royal Palace and the bustling marina quarter with its tangled streets, bars and restaurants.

DAY 3 Cagliari – Nora – Tuerredda beach – Cagliari (B)

A full day private excursion visiting Nora, the oldest village in Sardinia, for Carthaginian and Roman archaeological ruins dating to the 8th century BC. Afterward, enjoy the afternoon at Tuerredda beach with time for an independent lunch at their beachfront restaurant and to swim before heading back to Cagliari.

DAY 4 Cagliari – Su Naraxi di Barumini – Bosa – Alghero (B, L)

Enjoy a guided tour of the UNESCO World Heritage Listed Su Naraxi di Barumini. The defensive structures date to 2000BC and consist of circular towers of truncated cones built of stone. Continue to one of Sardinia's most renowned wineries for a cellar tour, tasting and light lunch. Afterward, enjoy a brief stop in the colourful village of Bosa before arriving in Alghero.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Smy Carlos V Wellness & Spa 5-star or similar

DAY 5 Alghero (B)

Enjoy a guided tour of the medieval fortified town of Alghero. Known as 'Little Barcelona' for its Catalan influence, the town boasts a striking Gothic-style historic centre with the Church of St Francis and Santa Maria Cathedral. Stroll the narrow lanes, walk the old town walls before embarking on a boat to Neptune's Grotto.

DAY 6 Alghero – Castelsardo – Costa Smeralda (B)

Depart for the Costa Smeralda region with a stop in Castelsardo, considered one of the most beautiful villages in Italy.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Club Hotel Baja Sardinia 4-star or similar

DAY 7 Costa Smeralda – Maddalena Archipelago – Costa Smeralda (B)

Enjoy a full day excursion with a small group sailing boat to the Maddalena Archipelago (weather permitting) consisting of 7 major islands featuring beautiful clear waters, wind-blown granite coastlines and significant wildlife.

DAY 8 Costa Smeralda – Olbia (B)

A private departure transfer to Olbia or to the ferry port if you are continuing with us to Corsica.

- > Upgrade to a seaside 5-star hotel in Costa Smeralda: recommended – Cervo Hotel Costa Smeralda Resort (Porto Cervo), Cala Di Volpe (Porto Cervo) or L'Ea Bianca Luxury Resort (Arzachena).
- > Incorporate a cooking class in Cagliari to learn the secrets of mastering the local gnocchi like pasta dish 'Maloreddus'.
- > Extend in the south to stay at the exclusive Faro Capo Spartivento 5-star lighthouse hotel in Chia or to a resort in Villasimius for its popular beaches.
- > Extend to stay in Orgosolo to visit its famous political murals, Mamoiada's carnival mask stores and/or to experience life as a shepherd with lunch.
