DAY 1 Venice – Cortina d'Ampezzo

On arrival in Venice, transfer to your spectacular hotel in Cortina d'Ampezzo for your upcoming exploration of the Dolomites. The Dolomites are listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage property for its exceptional natural beauty and feature some of the most beautiful landscapes anywhere, with vertical walls, sheer cliffs and narrow, deep valleys. On arrival in Cortina d'Ampezzo, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. The charming alpine resort town is surrounded by stunning peaks and hosted the 1956 (and upcoming 2026) Winter Olympics.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Faloria Mountain Spa Resort 5-star or similar

DAY 2 Cortina d'Ampezzo – Fanes Waterfalls – Cortina d'Ampezzo (B)

Embark on a captivating journey through the breathtaking landscapes of Cortina d'Ampezzo. Begin with a private sightseeing tour and a guided hike to the awe-inspiring Fanes Waterfalls (this will include snowshoeing during the winter). Immerse yourself in the stunning scenery and marvel at the snow-covered wonders during winter, before returning to Cortina for an evening of leisure.

DAY 3 Cortina d'Ampezzo – Cinque Torri – Corvara in Badia (B)

Visit the impressive five grey dolomite towers known as the Cinque Torri with a guided tour. Continue by chairlift through the forest for aerial views of the mountain range and WWI trenches below. Explore the trenches on foot with your guide and finish with a descent to the picturesque Alta Badia. The evening is at your leisure to roam the village to learn about the life of the 'Ladini' people.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Dolomites Lifestyle Hotel Marmolada 4-star or similar

DAY 4 Corvara in Badia (B)

Enjoy the day at leisure to explore with a full day cable car pass granting you access to the awe-inspiring heights of this iconic mountain range. Ascend to the renowned Pralongià High Plateau and be greeted by breathtaking vistas, including the mesmerising sight of the Marmolada Glacier, the highest peak of the Dolomites. Whether you visit during the snow-blanketed winter or the vibrant summer months, the region offers a myriad of activities to suit every adventurer.

Discover the charming atmosphere of Ortisei, where you'll have independent time to explore this picturesque village with an array of shops and bars. Continue your journey to Auna di Sotto, delving into the world of apple cultivation at a private apple farm. Engage your senses with an apple juice tasting, savouring the flavours of the region and experiencing the essence of its agricultural heritage. After arriving to your spectacular accommodation in Bolzano you have the evening at your leisure.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Castel Hörtenberg Hotel 5-star or similar

DAY 6 Bolzano (B)

Today enjoy a sightseeing tour of Balzano and learn about the unique mix of the Italian and Austrian cultures. Visit the South Tyrol Museum of Archaeology, which houses the famous mummy known as Ötzi the Iceman. Ötzi, a 5,300-year-old preserved body, provides valuable insights into prehistoric life and has become an iconic symbol of the region's archaeological significance. The afternoon is at your leisure. We recommend visiting the nearby Renon Plateau, accessible by a historic cable car providing stunning panoramic views of the surrounding landscapes.

DAY 7 Bolzano – Venice (B)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and transfer to Venice airport.
