Day 2 Paris (B)

Enjoy a full day excursion with driver and guide to visit Paris' main attractions including the Eiffel Tower, Arc de Triomphe, Place Vendôme, Place de la Concorde. Les Invalides, Jardin du Luxembourg, Notre Dame, Rue de Rivoli and Galerie des Tuileries. Day 3 Paris (B, D)

Enjoy a guided tour of the Louvre. Opened in 1793, the Museum houses impressive collections that include Painting, Sculpture, and Egyptian antiquities as well as renowned pieces such as the Mona Lisa, Venus de Milo and Madonna on the Rocks by Leonardo da Vinci. Afterward, visit the world-class art exhibition at Museum d'Orsay. In the evening, take a cruise on the Seine for a unique view of Paris by night and a 3-course dinner of French cuisine.

Day 4 Paris (B)

Enjoy a guided walking tour of the Left Bank including the Latin Quarter, Le Jardin du Luxembourg, Saint Germain's trendy streets and the Rodin Museum. Afterward, we recommend strolling the trendy streets of Saint-Germain.

Day 5 Paris - Champagne Region -Paris (B)

Enjoy a full day small group excursion to the Champagne region visiting Epernay, the town of Dom Perignon (Hautvillers) and the surrounding areas. The excursion includes tastings at champagne houses and a sabre demonstration for the art of opening champagne bottles.
