Day 1 San Sebastián

Welcome to Spain's Basque Country, a captivating region celebrated for its rugged coastline, vibrant culture, and world-renowned culinary scene. Arrive in San Sebastián to your beautiful hotel and unwind with an evening at leisure.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Hotel Catalonia Donosti 4-star or similar

Day 2 San Sebastián (B, L)

Enjoy a guided tour of elegant San Sebastián, a coastal gem known for its Belle Époque architecture, golden beaches and deep-rooted Basque identity. Discover the city's highlights including the lively Old Town, picturesque La Concha Bay and charming local markets. Along the way, enjoy a tasting of regional Txacoli and Pinto wines, followed by a welcome lunch with wine at a local restaurant. The rest of the afternoon is yours to relax or explore more of the city at your own pace.

Day 3 San Sebastián – Pamplona – Logroño (Rioja wine region) (B)

Enjoy the drive up to the Monte Igeldo lookout, offering breathtaking panoramic views over San Sebastián's La Concha Bay and the Cantabrian coastline. Continue inland to Pamplona, famously known for the Running of the Bulls and rich in medieval charm. Enjoy a guided walking tour through its historic heart, including a visit to the striking Gothic Pamplona Cathedral, whose impressive cloister is among the most beautiful in Europe. In the afternoon, travel to the world-renowned Rioja wine region and settle into your elegant accommodation.

Day 4 Logroño (Rioja region) – Laguardia – Logroño (Rioja region) (B, L)

Today, embark on a full-day exploration of the celebrated Rioja wine region, one of Spain's most prestigious Denominación de Origen Calificada (DOCa) areas. Known for its bold reds crafted from the Tempranillo grape, Rioja combines centuries-old wine traditions with modern innovation. Visit two local wineries for wine tastings, one inclusive of lunch with wine. Visit the fortified hilltop town of Laguardia, renowned for its

underground wine cellars and medieval architecture, with independent time to stroll its charming, cobbled streets and soak in its storybook atmosphere before returning to your hotel.

Day 5 Logroño (Rioja region) – Burgos – Salamanca (B)

Travel west to Burgos, a city steeped in history and birthplace of the legendary El Cid. Enjoy a guided tour with admission to the UNESCO-listed Cathedral of Saint Mary, a masterpiece of Spanish Gothic architecture famed for its soaring spires and ornate facades. Continue to Salamanca, one of

Spain's most beautiful Renaissance cities, and check into your stunning accommodation.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Hospes Palacio de San Esteban 5-star or similar

Day 6 Salamanca (B, L)

Start they day with a guided tour one of Europe's oldest and most prestigious universities, uncovering its hidden stories. Afterwards enjoy a local lunch with wine. The rest of the afternoon is yours to relax or explore the golden sandstone streets at your own pace.

Day 7 Salamanca – Toledo – Madrid (B)

Depart for the hilltop city of Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known as the "City of Three Cultures" for its historical blend of Christian, Jewish and Muslim influences. Enjoy a guided tour with visits to the Alcázar and the magnificent Gothic Cathedral. In the afternoon, continue to Madrid where the evening is at your leisure.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Hotel NH Collection Madrid Palacio de Tepa 5-star or similar

Day 8 Madrid (B, L)

Today's guided tour of Spain's vibrant capital includes the Royal Palace, Europe's largest functioning royal residence and a symbol of Spanish heritage and power. Afterwards, celebrate the journey with a closing tapas lunch paired with local wines, an iconic Spanish tradition of small share plates reflecting the country's regional diversity and social spirit.
