## Explore the beautiful countryside to discover Oxford, Stonehenge and Bath over 5 days, including the UNESCO Listed Sites of Blenheim Palace and Stonehenge.

#### Day 1 Oxford (Oxfordshire)

Explore the beautiful countryside to discover Oxford, Stonehenge and Bath. Arrive by train, self-drive or by private transfer. Oxford is famous for its University and the home of royalty and scholars. Today, its wonderful buildings, museums and bustling centre make it a 'must' visit. On arrival, enjoy a guided walk down its cobbled back streets. alleyways and secret corners. Cover the main sites including Christ Church College, Radcliffe Square & Observatory, the Covered Market, Bodleian Library, The Sheldonian Theatre, St Mary The Virgin Church, the Oxford Castle guarter and Botanical Gardens.

### Day 2 Oxford (B)

Enjoy a guided tour of Bodleian Library, inside the historic rooms and Radcliffe

Camera. Visit Pitt Rivers Museum for the anthropologist's 20,000-piece collection of wonderful objects. Other options include Ashmolean Museum (the UK's oldest), Oxford University Museum, hiring a wooden punt and climbing the Saxon Tower of St Michael. Otherwise, take in a performance at the Choral Evensong, New Theatre Oxford, Oxford Playhouse or The Sheldonian or just enjoy Oxford's wonderful restaurant, shops and bars.

### Day 3 Oxford – Blenheim Palace – Woodstock – Stonehenge – Bath (B)

Return to Broadway for a heartwarming Christmas Eve celebration at the historic Lygon Arms Hotel. Begin with a traditional carol performance, before indulging in a sumptuous three-course Wellington Feast in the hotel's elegant dining room, complete with a glass of champagne to toast the night, all while looking forward to Christmas morning.

#### Day 4 Bath (B)

Enjoy a guided walking tour of the town's main attractions including the Roman Baths, Bath Abbey, Bath Street, and 'the Circus' and Royal Crescent which has been awarded as one of England's most picturesque streets. Afterward, relax in the thermal waters of one of its renowned spas or keep exploring this enchanting town.
