

Day 1 Venice

Day 4 Corvara in Badia – Cinque Torri - Corvara in Badia (B. L. D)

Today, embark on a breathtaking panoramic experience as you ride the cable car to the remarkable Cinque Torri. Afterwards, visit a local deer farm for an immersive experience into traditional alpine agriculture, followed by a light lunch of regional specialties. Return to Corvara in Badia and enjoy a relaxed evening with dinner at the hotel.











Day 5 Corvara in Badia (B, D)

Enjoy a day at leisure to discover the mountains at your own pace. Use your cable car pass to visit the Amphitheatre of the Dolomites' as you travel to the Pralongià High Plateau with stunning panoramic views and beautiful flower meadows in the summer. Perhaps enjoy lunch with stunning views before descending to discover the town further or simply unwind at your hotel before an organised dinner.

Day 6 Corvara in Badia – Ortisei – Bolzano (B)

Travel through the Dolomites to Ortisei, a charming village renowned for its woodcarving tradition and idyllic landscapes. Spend time exploring the town's artistic heritage, cafes, and boutiques before continuing to Bolzano. In the afternoon, enjoy a wine tasting at a local wine store to experience the unique flavours of South Tyrol's renowned vineyards.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Parkhotel Laurin 4-star or similar

Day 7 Bolzano (B)

Delve into Bolzano's rich cultural tapestry with a guided tour of the city, including a visit to the South Tyrol Museum of Archaeology, home to the famed Ötzi the Iceman. Learn about the region's fascinating blend of Austrian and Italian influences before an afternoon at leisure to explore Bolzano's picturesque arcades, lively squares, and inviting cafes.

Day 8 Bolzano - Milan (B, L)



Celebrate the cultural crossroads and culinary traditions of Italy's undiscovered northeast.

Day 1 Venice (Fusina) - Trieste

Transfer to Venice train station to board your high-speed train to Trieste. On arrival transfer to your hotel and welcome to this fascinating port city which sits at the crossroads of Latin, Slavic, and Germanic cultures. Once part of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, its grandeur is still visible in the elegant architecture and stately piazzas. Settle into your hotel and enjoy an evening at leisure.



Day 1 Cortona

Welcome to Tuscany's rolling hills and a gastronomy focused tasting of the region. Check in to your amazing hotel just outside the town. Freshen up before joining an introductory sampler - a winery tour and wine tasting followed by an evening to relax.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: Il Falconiere Relais & Chateaux 5-star

Day 2 Cortona (B, D)

Cortona is a hilltop town with predominantly medieval architecture, steep narrow streets, significant museums and a historic centre. While the origins of the settlement are Umbrian, it was the Etruscans that developed the town and eventually became a Roman colony. Learn more of the history and the gastronomic significance of the surrounding region on a private guided walking tour.

In the afternoon, enjoy a Michelin Star cooking class experience designed by Silvia Baracchi, celebrating traditional Tuscan recipes, followed by dinner.

Day 3 Cortona – Montepulciano – Val d'Orcia (B, L)

Enjoy breakfast before journeying through the Tuscan countryside into the picturesque Val d'Orcia. Stop in Montepulciano, a major producer of produce including pork, cheese, 'pici' pasta and of course wine.
