Day 1 Rome – Viterbo

Day 2 Viterbo (B)

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of Viterbo. Discover its well-preserved medieval quarter, admire the Papal Palace, and visit the Cathedral of San Lorenzo, a landmark steeped in history. Spend the afternoon at leisure exploring artisan shops, thermal baths, and relaxed piazzas.

Day 3 Viterbo – Caprarola – Ronciglione – Viterbo (B)

Visit Caprarola to tour the magnificent Palazzo Farnese, an architectural masterpiece of the Renaissance surrounded by lush gardens. Continue to the charming town of Ronciglione, known for its beautiful lake views and traditional character, where you'll have time to explore independently before returning to Viterbo for an evening at leisure.
