Ávila's Medieval Walls and Cathedral

Journey through the heart of Castile, discovering the historic cities of Salamanca, Burgos, Ávila, and Segovia. This immersive itinerary blends UNESCO heritage, medieval architecture, and authentic culinary experiences.

Day 1 Salamanca

Golden, intellectual, and historic, welcome to Salamanca - one of Spain's most celebrated university cities, famed for its honey-coloured sandstone architecture and vibrant academic heritage dating back to the 13th century. Arrive at your hotel and check in. Your evening is at leisure; consider wandering through the magnificent Plaza Mayor, enjoying tapas in a lively bar, or taking an evening stroll along the illuminated cathedral.

STAY 3 NIGHTS: Hospes Palacio de San Esteban 5-star or similar

Day 2 Salamanca (B)

After breakfast, meet your private guide for an inspiring walking tour uncovering the secrets and legends of Salamanca University, one of the oldest in Europe and a centre of learning since 1218. Explore the city's historic streets and visit the Salamanca Cathedral, a striking blend of Gothic and Baroque architecture. Your afternoon is at leisure. Perhaps visit Casa de las Conchas, enjoy panoramic views from the cathedral towers, or relax in Plaza Mayor with a coffee.

Day 3 Salamanca – Guijuelo – Candelario – Salamanca (B, L)

Enjoy breakfast before meeting your driver for a full-day excursion into the Castilian countryside. Travel to Guijuelo, renowned as Spain's premier

region for Jamón Ibérico, where you'll enjoy a guided tasting experience and lunch, learning about traditional curing methods passed down through generations. Continue to the charming mountain village of Candelario, known for its well-preserved architecture, flower-filled balconies, and historic ties to the meat-curing industry. Enjoy free time to explore before returning to Salamanca.

Day 4 Salamanca – Burgos – Ávila (B)

After breakfast, check out and meet your driver for your journey to Ávila, stopping in Burgos, a historic city along the Camino de Santiago. Enjoy a guided visit to the magnificent UNESCO-listed Burgos Cathedral of St Mary, one of Spain's finest Gothic cathedrals, renowned for its intricate façade, soaring spires, and the tomb of El Cid. Enjoy free time for lunch before continuing to Ávila. Check in to your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

STAY 3 NIGHTS: Sofraga Palacio

Day 5 Ávila (B)

After breakfast, meet your private guide for a walking tour of Ávila, famed for its remarkably preserved medieval walls, among the best in Europe and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Walk along sections of the walls and visit the Ávila Cathedral, uniquely integrated into the city's fortifications. Your afternoon is at leisure. Consider visiting the Convent of Saint Teresa, exploring local pastry shops for the famous yemas de Ávila, or enjoying views over the surrounding plains.

Day 6 Ávila – Segovia – Ávila (B)

Enjoy breakfast before meeting your driver for a day trip to Segovia, one of Spain's most picturesque historic cities. Enjoy a guided walking tour including the Roman Aqueduct, an extraordinary feat of ancient engineering still standing after nearly 2,000 years, the fairytale-like Alcázar of Segovia, and the impressive Gothic Segovia Cathedral. Enjoy some free time to explore or sample the region's famous roast suckling pig before returning to Ávila. Your evening is at leisure to enjoy your final night..

Day 7 Ávila (B)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and continue your onward journey.
