Discover the rich history, golden sandstone architecture, and culinary heritage of Salamanca and its surrounding villages.

Day 1 Salamanca

Golden, historic, and vibrant, welcome to Salamanca! Arrive at your hotel and check in. Salamanca is renowned for its stunning sandstone architecture, lively university atmosphere, and the UNESCO-listed Plaza Mayor. Spend the evening at leisure, perhaps wandering the cobble streets, enjoying the cafés, or soaking in the warm glow of the city's historic squares.

Day 2 Salamanca (B)

After breakfast, meet your private guide for the Salamanca Inspiring Experience: Secrets & Legends of the University walking tour. Discover hidden courtyards, ancient symbols, and fascinating tales linked to one of Europe's oldest universities. Visit

Salamanca Cathedral, with its blend of Gothic and Baroque architecture, and explore the historic halls of Salamanca University, founded in 1218. Your afternoon is at leisure to enjoy further city exploration, such as shopping in local boutiques or sampling regional cuisine.

Day 3 Salamanca – Guijuelo – Candelario – Salamanca (B, L)

After breakfast, meet your driver for a full-day excursion. Begin in Guijuelo, Spain's premier Iberian ham region, with the Lisardo Castro "The Origins" Guided Tour. Learn about the traditional curing methods and sample a selection of premium hams and Iberian products (2 hours). Continue to the charming mountain village of Candelario, known for its preserved architecture, narrow alleys, and centuries-old culinary

traditions. Enjoy independent time to stroll the town before returning to Salamanca in the afternoon.

Day 4 Salamanca – Los Arribes del Duero – Salamanca (B)

After breakfast, depart for a scenic full-day tour of Los Arribes del Duero, a dramatic natural park on the Spanish-Portuguese border. Stop at iconic viewpoints to admire the deep river gorges and striking cliffs. Visit a local winery for a private tasting with lunch, sampling regional wines paired with local delicacies. Return to Salamanca in the late afternoon for an evening at leisure.

Day 5 Salamanca (B)

Enjoy breakfast before checking out of your hotel for your onward journey. Optional extensions are available for further exploration of Castile and León.
