Day 1 Madrid

Elegant, and vibrant, welcome to Madrid! Meet your private driver and transfer to your hotel for check in. Spend the evening at leisure discovering the city's more hidden charms – perhaps a relaxed stroll through the Malasaña neighborhood's bohemian streets, or enjoy a cocktail at a rooftop terrace

Day 2 Madrid (B)

After breakfast, enjoy some free time before a small group food tour through the vibrant streets of Madrid, discovering the city's rich culinary culture as you sample a variety of authentic Spanish delicacies that define the Spanish capital.

Day 3 Madrid – San Lorenzo de El Escorial – Segovia – Madrid (B)

After breakfast, meet your driver for a full-day excursion. Begin at San Lorenzo de El Escorial, home to the monumental El Escorial Monastery and Royal Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site famed for its Renaissance architecture, royal history, and impressive library. Spend independent time at the Valley of the Fallen, an iconic 20th-century memorial set within dramatic mountainous terrain. Continue to the UNESCO-listed historic city of Segovia, enjoying independent lunch before a private guided walking tour of the Alcázar and Cathedral, and admire the Roman Aqueduct from the exterior. Return to Madrid for an evening at leisure.

Day 4 Madrid – Cuenca – Madrid (B)

After breakfast, transfer to Madrid train station for your high-speed train journey to Cuenca. Meet your private guide for a walking tour of Cuenca's cliffside old town, known for its "hanging houses" perched above the Huécar Gorge. Visit the Catedral de Santa María y San Julián, a stunning Gothic cathedral with centuries of history. Return to Madrid by high-speed train and then transfer back to your hotel. The rest of your evening is at leisure..

Day 5 Madrid (B)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel for your onward journey.
