Day 1 Porto – Dão Wine Region – Guarda – Salamanca (Spain)

Vibrant and historic, welcome to Porto. Meet your driver at the port, airport, or train station and begin your journey from Portugal into Spain. Travel through Portugal's scenic countryside to the Dão Wine Region, one of the country's oldest and most prestigious wine areas, known for its elegant reds and granite-rich terroir. Enjoy a private winery visit with a tasting of premium wines paired with regional cheeses and charcuterie. Continue to Guarda, Portugal's highest city, for a short stop to explore its historic centre and mountain views. Cross into Spain and arrive in Salamanca, where you'll check in to your hotel. Your evening is at leisure.

Day 2 Salamanca (B)

After breakfast, meet your private guide for an inspiring walking tour uncovering the secrets and legends of Salamanca University, one of the

oldest in Europe. Explore the historic streets and visit the Salamanca Cathedral, an architectural blend of Gothic and Baroque styles. The afternoon is at leisure.

Day 3 Salamanca – Guijuelo – Candelario – Salamanca (B, L)

Enjoy breakfast before meeting your driver for a full day excursion into the Castilian countryside. Travel to Guijuelo, Spain's most renowned region for Jamón Ibérico, where you'll enjoy a guided experience and tasting lunch, learning about the traditional curing process. Continue to the picturesque village of Candelario, known for its preserved stone houses with wooden balconies. Enjoy free time to explore before returning to Salamanca for the evening at leisure.

Day 4 Salamanca (B)
